PALESTINE, Ill.— Pfc. Jacob Timothy Tracy, 20, of Palestine died Sunday, June 17, 2007, in Iraq as a result of injuries sustained in combat. He was born Sept. 20, 1986, in Paris to Donald Eugene Tracy and Sheila Dove Cook Tracy. He attended Palestine High School and Pilgrim Holiness Church in rural Palestine. He served in the U.S. Army 2nd Brigade, First Troop, 8th Cavalry, in the regular Army.
